TREATY OF WAITANGI POLICY
Revised: April 2010



PURPOSE

To provide guidelines to ensure that the curriculum and environment of Wakari School reflects the Principles of Partnership contained in the Treaty of Waitangi and New Zealand's bi-cultural heritage.

OBJECTIVES

1. Children will be given the opportunity to recognise the significance and importance of Māori and Pakeha values.
2. Children's knowledge of Māori customs, language and culture will be developed as they progress through the school.
3. Children whose parents wish them to further extend their knowledge of Te Reo Māori and Tikanga will be given the opportunity to do so (within the resources available).
4. Tolerant attitudes between Māori, Pakeha and all other cultures in the school and community will be encouraged.
5. A staff member will be designated the responsibility of providing access to resources for implementing this policy.
6. Facilities and funding for teacher training and the implementation of appropriate available programmes will be provided (within the resources available).
7. Liaison with and the involvement of the local Māori community will occur whenever possible.

EFFECTIVENESS REVIEW

- 1 This policy will be reviewed by the board in accordance with its triennial programme of self-review.
