## **Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)**



Wakari School has now introduced Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) for Senior Syndicate children. This is a completely *voluntary programme*. However, there are many benefits to engaging in this programme:

- 1. The device will last at least 3 years and will cater for your child's needs at Intermediate or High School.
- 2. Your child will get the best possible access to digital devices while at school.
- 3. It teaches your child to manage and take responsibility for their own device.

We recommend Chromebooks as the preferred device. These are affordable and cater for the needs of your child. **Minimum specifications: 4GB RAM, 32GB storage, 11**" **screen.** 

Wakari School has partnered up with Noel Leeming to get Chromebooks at a special price. To access this, there are two options:

- Go into your local Noel Leeming store and say you are from Wakari School and needing a BYOD device.

After purchasing your Chromebook, you will need to login with a google account. This account will be the administrator account. We recommend that you do this at home. When your child brings the device to school, they will login with their school account and we will connect them to our WIFI network.
